1. Telugu

Structure:

- Slot 0: Root
- Slot 1: Aux:
 - Further conjugatable: **cēyu** transitive, **iccu** permissive, **kalugu** potential
 - Not further conjugatable: valayunu *must*, vaccunu *may*, rādu *may not*, kūḍadu *should not*
- Slot 2: Tense: -cunn- present, -in- past
- Slot 3: Person:
 - Indicative: -MARKER
 - Potential: **kalugu** > **kala** + CONS + -**u**

MARKER: **ānu** 1sg, **āvu** 2sg, **ādu** 3sg masc, **adi** 3sg neut, **āmu** 1 pl, **āru** 2pl, **avi** 3pl CONS: consonant used in marker

• Slot 4: Polar Question -ā

Sound Changes:

 Verbs take the infinitive before auxiliaries. It is usually formed by changing the last vowel to ã, but vaccu "to come" is irregular and has the infinitive of rã.

Then $\tilde{\circ} > n / V$ and $\emptyset / [+C, -plosive]$, while voicing the initial plosives of auxiliaries.

- 2. Ŭ1+V2=V2
- 3. -yu- + -in- > -sin-

Arasunna Rules for Roots: in the root, arasunna can only come before single plosives, but doesn't necessarily come before all of them.
