Solutions

1. Telugu

Structure:

- Slot 0: Root
- Slot 1: Aux:
 - Further conjugatable: **cēyu** transitive, **iccu** permissive, **kalugu** potential
 - Not further conjugatable: **valayunu** *must*, **vaccunu** *may*, **rādu** *may not*, **kūḍadu** *should not*
- Slot 2: Tense: **-cunn-** present, **-in-** past
- Slot 3: Person:
 - Indicative: **-MARKER**
 - Potential: **kalugu** > **kala-** + CONS + **-u**

MARKER: **ānu** 1sg, **āvu** 2sg, **āḍu** 3sg masc, **adi** 3sg neut, **āmu** 1 pl, **āru** 2pl, **avi** 3pl

CONS: consonant used in marker

- Slot 4: Polar Question **-ā**

Sound Changes:

1. Verbs take the infinitive before auxiliaries. It is usually formed by changing the last vowel to **ā**, but **vaccu** “to come” is irregular and has the infinitive of **rā**.
Then **ō** > **n** / **_V** and **Ø** / **_** [+C, -plosive], while voicing the initial plosives of auxiliaries.
2. **Ṽ1+V2=V2**
3. **-yu-** + **-in-** > **-sin-**

Arasunna Rules for Roots: in the root, arasunna can only come before single plosives, but doesn't necessarily come before all of them.

There are three grammatical differences in Ma'di between present and past:

	Present	Past
Verb-Obj order	OV	VO
3rd person marker	ka (separate word that comes after subject)	O-
"it" object	-A	unmarked

Word Order: S VO/OV PP FOC (FOC = **au** and focuses the object)

Noun Phrase: Noun CASE

Cases: **?a** (possessive), **si** (*in*), **ga** (*towards*), **ga si** (*from*), **ni** (benefactive).

Irregular pluralization.

* **kazoro** + **robo** are merged into a single word **kazorobo**, which is the answer for task (b).
